Arriving at Trentham

You will be coming to Trentham Gardens for the day. Once you have arrived in the car park you will walk to our Visitor Centre.

You may have to wait in the queue with your family before you can go into the gardens. If you are visiting with your school you will need to wait in a group before you can go inside the gardens. You will be given a ticket.

There is a café inside the visitor centre, and there may be other people waiting who you don't know. It can be noisy while you are waiting.



What you will find inside Trentham Gardens

There are lots of things to see and do in the gardens. There are lots of plants, trees and flowers from around the world planted.

There are also fairies to find, and lots of sculptures to discover.

There is also lots of wildlife to see during the day. You might see birds, squirrels, butterflies and sheep when you are walking around.



What you will find inside Trentham Gardens

When you walk around you might see lots of other people who are also visiting the gardens.

Some people bring their children and pet dogs for a walk. Our staff make sure that dogs are always kept on a lead when they are here.



What you will find inside Trentham Gardens

You might also see our Miniature Train called 'Fern'. You can buy tickets to take a train ride along the lake with your family or friends.

The train can make noise when the driver sounds the horn. This is important to make sure that our passengers know that we are leaving.

We also have a boat called 'Miss Elizabeth', you can also buy tickets to sail on this. You may need to wait in a queue for tickets or for the boat to dock.



Who works at Trentham

We have lots of people who work at Trentham Gardens who would like to help you and answer your questions. If you get lost you can talk to us and we will help you to find your family.

They are very friendly and wear purple polo shirts with Trentham Gardens written on them.

Some of our staff might be driving tractors or gardening. Sometimes the machines can make noise.

You can bring your assistance dog with you if you would like, they are allowed on the play area with you.

There is a Barefoot Walk beside the play area. You can take your shoes and socks off and walk along a special path where you can feel things like sand, mud and moss between your toes.

Sometimes we have visitors who run activities inside the gardens. These can include things like archery, sports games, and animal workshops where you can meet some small animals. Your parents can find out more about these on our website.



Places to eat at Trentham

There are two dining outlets inside the gardens where you can find lots of food and drinks during the day. You might have to queue to wait for the food to be cooked.

The gardens can get busy but there are lots of places where you can go for some quiet time. If you would prefer to bring a picnic there are lots of quiet places where you can relax and eat.
